#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to the Packing of Sardines.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 41, § 78, amended. The third sentence of section 78 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The minimum quantity of oil shall be not less than four pounds per case of one hundred one-quarter size cans and the oil shall be a vegetable or cottonseed of a grade not below that of "Prime Summer Yellow." "Prime Winter Yellow Cottonseed Oil."'
