AN ACT Relating to Registration of Voters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 6, additional. Chapter 6 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting therein a new section to be numbered 18-A and to read as follows:

'Sec. 18-A. Duties of registration board; penalties. Registration boards shall attach to the register of voters a jurat attested to by any person by law authorized to administer oaths setting forth their compliance with the provisions of sections 17 and 18. Any member of any board failing to comply with the provisions of this and the 2 preceding sections shall be punished by a fine of \$25.'
