AN ACT Granting Special Voting Rights to Rockwood Plantation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Seperate polling booth for Rockwood plantation. The county commissioners of Somerset county shall establish a polling place in the plantation of Rockwood for state and national elections. They shall select four citizens, residents in Rockwood, 2 from each of the largest political parties to supervise the elections. The expense of such elections shall be assessed against the plantation.
