STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Sell Certain Public Lots in Webster Plantation, in Penobscot County.

Forest commissioner authorized to sell lots in Webster plantation. Resolved: That the forest commissioner is hereby authorized to sell and convey to actual settlers thereon certain lands in Webster plantation, in Penobscot county, constituting part of the school lots of said plantation, if he deems advisable, for such price per acre and on such terms of payment as he may deem advantageous; and provided that the proceeds of any sales made shall be added to the school fund of said plantation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land is occupied by Alfred Smith and others of Webster plantation. They wish to secure a better title than the squatters' claims or deeds which they now have.
