STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

Ordered, the Senate concurring, that the commissioner of education be instructed to develop, in cooperation with the representatives of the state-aided academies in the state, a plan whereby the total aids granted academies shall be fully reflected in reduced tuition rates granted by such academies to public school authorities for Maine pupils. Such plan shall provide for a gradual decrease of tuition rates until the total aids now granted annually, or which shall hereafter be granted, shall be fully reflected in reduced tuition rates after July 1, 1945. The commissioner of education shall report such plan to a subsequent session of the legislature.
