AN ACT Relating to Clerks of Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 93, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 93 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Appointment; tenure. Clerks of the judicial courts shall be elected and notified, their elections determined and vacancies filled in the same manner, and they shall enter upon the discharge of their duties at the same time as is provided respecting county commissioners, but they shall hold their offices for 4 years appointed by the supreme judicial court to serve at the pleasure of the court.'
