STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Bounty on Bobcats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 77, amended. The first sentence of section 77 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a bounty of \$10 for every bobeat, loupcervier and Canada lynx, and \$20 for every bobcat which is killed within the state, to be paid by the treasurer of state to the person killing the same upon compliance with the following conditions.'
