STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Licenses to Operate Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 65, amended. Section 65 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 65. Termination of registrations and licenses to operate. All registrations of vehicles, all certificates of registration and number plates, ~~and all licenses to operate motor vehicles~~ shall terminate and become void at midnight on the 31st day of December of each year; except as provided in paragraph 2 of section 55 of this chapter. **All licenses to operate motor vehicles shall terminate one year after their date of issue** and no person shall operate any motor vehicle on or after ~~the first day of January of any year unless then duly licensed to operate such vehicle for such year.~~ **the date of termination of said license unless then duly authorized to operate such vehicle.'**
