STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Rebate on Gasoline Tax To Lobster Fishermen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 12, § 80, amended. Section 80 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

'Rebate on gasoline tax for lobster fishermen provided for. ', and provided further that the additional cent of the tax so paid upon such internal combustion fuel used in motor boats used in the pursuit of fishing shall be appropriated for the benefit of the department of sea and shore fisheries, to be expended by the said department for the purchase of legal length seed lobsters at the current market price; said lobsters to be immediately released for the benefit of future lobster fishing.'
