**AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Eliot & Kittery Mutual Fire
Insurance Company.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L. 1884, c. 164, § 9, amended. Section 9 of chapter 164 of the private and special laws of 1844 is hereby amended to read as follows: 'Said company may make insurance for any term of time, not exceeding 7 years, on any house or other building, household furniture, machinery and goods in any building in the state of Maine, against damage by fire originating from any cause other than design in the insured.'
