AN ACT Relating to Fees of Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 126, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 126 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 56 of the public laws of 1933, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 6. Fees of jurors. Grand and traverse jurors, attending the superior court, and jurors attending on any other occasion prescribed by law, shall be allowed \$4 \$5 a day for their attendance, Sundays and holidays ~~excepted~~ **included**, and 6 cents a mile for their travel out and home, to be paid out of the county treasury.'
