STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Discharge of Firearms across Highways while Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, additional; relating to discharge of firearms across highways. Chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 52-B, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 52-B. Discharge of firearms across highways, forbidden; penalty. No person shall while hunting or at target practice so discharge any firearm so that said charge shall be propelled along, from or across any highway or way which is open to the public. Any violation of this section shall be punished by the penalty set forth in the 1st paragraph of section 107.'
