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AN ACT Relating to the Powers and Duties of Superintendents.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 19, § 70, ¶ (e), amended.** Paragraph (e) of section 70 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

**‘(e) Shall nominate teachers; election to be approved by committee.** He shall nominate all teachers subject to such regulations governing salaries and the qualifications of teachers as the superintending school committee shall make, and upon the approval of nominations by said committee he may employ teachers so nominated and approved. **Provided, in case the superintendent of schools and the superintending school committee fail to legally elect a teacher, the commissioner of education shall have authority to appoint a substitute teacher who shall serve until such election is made.’**
