STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Lights on Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Lights on trucks, regulated. The first sentence of the fifth paragraph of section 82 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following inserted in place thereof:

'All motor vehicles of 7 feet or over in width shall have thereon at the extreme left on the body at the upper and lower part of the body both in front and rear, red lamps visible for a distance of at least 200 feet ahead or behind (as the case may be) of such vehicle.'
