STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Forcible Entry and Detainer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 108, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 108 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Jurisdiction. Trial justices and judges of municipal courts have jurisdiction of cases of forcible entry and detainer respecting estates within their counties. Such judges have exclusive jurisdiction of such cases within their cities or towns, unless interested.'
