STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relative to Bounty on Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 79, suspended. Bounty on bears in towns where damage is being caused to valuable domestic animals. The provisions of section 79 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes are hereby suspended until June 30, 1937.
