IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 44, amended. Section 44 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out said section and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 44. Sunday hunting regulated. It shall not be lawful to hunt any wild animal or wild bird, on Sunday, within $\frac{1}{2}$ mile of a church or chapel.'
