IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Relating to Moose Hunting in Waldo and Knox Counties.

Three day over season on moose in Waldo and Knox counties. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation declaring an open season on moose in the counties of Waldo and Knox for such 3 day period during 1935 as seems best in his judgment; and be it further

Resolved: That licenses shall be required for non-residents of this state to hunt, catch or kill moose in Waldo and Knox counties and that the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to charge a license fee therefor of \$25 per season.
