STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Mill Tax Highway Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. L. 1931, c. 251, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 251 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. General highway fund established. To provide funds for the construction of state aid and third class highways, for the maintenance of state and state aid highways and interstate, intrastate and international bridges, and for other items of expenditure hereinafter specified, there is hereby established a fund to be known as "the general highway fund." This fund shall include all fees received from the registration of motor vehicles and licensing of operators thereof, the receipts from the tax of one mill on the valuation of the state known as the mill tax highway fund, the receipts from the tax on gasoline and internal combustion motor fuels, the appropriation of three hundred thousand dollars provided for in section forty two of chapter twenty eight of the revised statutes, all fines, forfeitures and costs accruing to the state under section 118 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, and all sums received on account of the state highway commission for permits to open highways or from other sources the disposition of which is not otherwise designated by law."

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 28, § 43, repealed. Section 43 of chapter 28 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.
