STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Authorizing the Adjutant-General to Grant a Permit to the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company at Camp Keyes

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Adjutant-general may permit telephone etc. construction at Camp Keyes. The adjutant-general may from time to time grant a permit or permits to the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company, its successors and assigns, to erect, construct, maintain and operate its lines of telephone and telegraph upon, over and beneath the premises in Augusta known as Camp Keyes, upon such terms and conditions and for such period of time as he thinks proper.
