## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Clerks of Courts for Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The 15th paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Waldo county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$1560; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$780: for clerks in the office of the clerk of courts, \$700, \$800.'
