AN ACT Relating to Publishing of Unsigned Communications.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Unsigned communications not to be published. All communications published in whole or in part by newspapers in the state, other than those received from reporters or news collectors in the regular course of their business, must be published with the name of the person, firm or corporation who signed the communication. No unsigned communications shall be published except those received from reporters or news collectors in the regular course of their business.
