**AN ACT Relating to the Classification and Compensation of State
Employees.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Classification and compensation plan. The classification and compensation plan of the personnel service of the state of Maine as worked out by the bureau of budget and as partially adopted by the governor and council under provisions of chapter 81 of the public laws of 1933 (an attested copy of which is on file in the office of the state budget officer) is hereby made effective in its entirety.
