STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Authorize the Recorder of the Lewiston Municipal Court to Destroy Certain Writs, Complaints, Warrants, Executions and Libels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. May destroy certain records. The judge and the recorder of the Lewiston Municipal Court are hereby authorized to destroy any and all writs, complaints, warrants, executions and libels which have been entered in and issued out of said municipal court prior to January 1st, 1920.
- Sec. 2. Certified copies of records may be issued. Said judge or recorder are hereby authorized whenever required to issue certified copies of the records of any and all writs, complaints, warrants, executions and libels authorized to be destroyed under section I of this act.
