STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Propagation and Cultivation of Quahaugs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 242, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 242 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. General provisions. Upon application in writing, the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries shall grant a written license to any owner of tide flats, other than those used as public bathing beaches, for the purpose of cultivating and propagating quahaugs upon not more than $\frac{1}{5}$ acres $\frac{1}{4}$ of said owner's total flats between high and low water mark within the limits to be specified in the license for a term of 10 years, and said license may be assigned by the said licensee. All such licenses shall be subject to such rules and regulations as are approved by the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries. The same may not be assigned, except as hereinafter provided.'
