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**AN ACT Relating to Hunting Foxes in Franklin County.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 72, amended.** Section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes as amended, compiled and published by the revisor of statutes in accordance with the provisions of chapter 104 of the public laws of 1931, is further amended by adding after the word "Oxford" in the nineteenth line thereof the following: 'except that it shall be lawful to hunt foxes with a dog and gun from October 16th to the last day of February, both days inclusive, in the county of Franklin.'
