STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, for the Screening of the Main Inlet of Cobbosseecontee Lake,
in the County of Kennebec.

Screening of Cobbosseecontee Lake. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$1,750, to be taken from the appropriation for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries and game, to aid in the screening of the main inlet of Cobbosseecontee Lake, located in the county of Kennebec; provided, however, that said appropriation shall not be available until some responsible person, corporation, or incorporated fish and game club, or the town in which the inlet of the lake or pond above mentioned is situated, or some other town in the county of Kennebec, in which said waters are situated, shall have agreed to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of the water through the same; and provided, further, that the state shall be liable for only one-half of the cost of said screen.
