**AN ACT Relating to the Placing of Political Advertisements Upon
Automobiles.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Unlawful for other than owner to place a political advertisement upon an automobile. It shall be unlawful for any person to place a political advertisement upon an automobile not owned by him.

Sec. 2. Definitions. As used in this act "political advertisement" means any paper, cardboard or other material carrying thereon an advertisement for political purposes, for any person, persons or political party.

Sec. 3. Penalty. A person placing political advertisements upon an automobile contrary to the provisions of this act shall be punished for each offense by a fine of not less than \$5, nor more than \$25.
