STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relative to Fees for Registration of Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 54, relating to fees for registration of vehicles, amended. Subdivision "a" of section 54 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

'Provided, also, that motor vehicles owned by residents of any state, province or foreign country where residents of the state of Maine registering motor vehicles are required to pay double the fees charged against resident owners, shall pay double the fees indicated above, whether for private use or for livery or hire.'
