STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Prohibiting the State to Insure Any of its Property Against Fire.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The state shall not insure any of its property against fire.
