RESOLVE, Relative to Game Preserve in York County.

Game preserve established in Acton, Newfield or Shapleigh in York county. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby authorized to establish a game preserve in the towns of Acton, Newfield or Shapleigh not to exceed 1000 acres if deemed advisable by the commissioner for the preservation and conservation of game in that locality.
