STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 1, additional. Chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered section 294-A and to read as follows:

'Sec. 294-A. Governor of tribe to issue certificates of memberships to members; penalty for posing as Indian. The governor of each of said tribes shall issue to each member thereof a certificate stating that its bearer is a member of said tribe.

Whoever, not a member Indian of either of said tribes, represents himself to be such Indian, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.'
