STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Appointment of Humane Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 135, § 70, amended. Section 70 of chapter 135 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof.

'Sec. 70. Appointment of humane agents. The sheriffs and deputy sheriffs of counties and the police officers of cities and constables of towns, shall constitute the humane agents of the state, with the same jurisdiction they now have as sheriffs, deputy sheriffs, police officers and constables. The fees for this service for civil deputies, police officers and constables shall be 75 cents and mileage. No extra fee shall be paid per diem officers, but they may charge mileage.'
