STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Deputy Sheriffs of Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The sheriff of Lincoln county may designate not more than 2 deputy sheriffs who may devote their entire time to criminal investigations and law enforcement, who shall receive as compensation therefor the sum of \$3 a day to be paid from the county treasury together with all necessary expenses.
