AN ACT Relative to the Sale of Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 95, amended. Chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by repealing section 95 and adding in place thereof the following section.

'Sec. 95. Sale of deer forbidden. No person, firm or corporation shall at any time sell any deer or part thereof taken in the state of Maine.

Whoever violates any provisions of this section shall be subject to the penalty provided for in section 107.'
