IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Abatement of Taxes in Thomaston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Abatement to Thomaston of taxes. The department of finance is directed and required annually to abate to the town of Thomaston from its taxes a sum equal to the amount of taxes which legally would be assessable upon the property, real and personal, owned by the state of Maine, for the use of which the state receives remuneration.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state owns property in Thomaston which it rents and receives remuneration therefor.
