STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Hancock-Sullivan Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Hancock-Sullivan bridge bonds to be paid by the state. The state shall pay to the trustees of the Hancock-Sullivan Bridge District such sums of money, as and when it becomes necessary for the said district to retire the bonds authorized by chapter 120 of the private and special laws of 1921 so far as they relate to the bridge district and the county of Hancock, as may be necessary to retire said bonds.
