STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Tax for Support of University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 19, § 117, amended. Section 117 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 117. Tax to be assessed to support University of Maine. A tax of five-sixths of a mill on a dollar shall annually be assessed upon the property in the state according to the valuation thereof and shall be known as the tax for the support of the University of Maine.'

Sec. 2. Limitation. This act shall be in force and effect for a period of 2 years only.
