STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Charitable and Benevolent Institutions, for the Care and Support of Children.

Charitable and benevolent institutions; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1936, the sum of \$5000 and for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1937, the sum of \$4000; for the care and support of children under the age of 16 years, including those supported away from their parents under the provisions of sections 51 to 55, inclusive, of chapter 64 of the revised statutes, and acts amendatory thereof, at not to exceed \$3.50 per week including direct payment from sources other than the state.
