# STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT to Establish a Boundary Line for the Town of Fayette.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Boundary line for Fayette established. The boundary line of the town of Fayette shall be, and hereby is, established as follows, to wit: Beginning at the northeast corner of the town of Livermore Falls, thence southerly as marked by stone monuments recognized and accepted as town line markers by said towns of Fayette and Livermore Falls to the north line of the town of Wayne; thence easterly as marked by stone monuments recognized and accepted by Wayne and Favette as town line markers to the westerly shore of Lovejoy (Lane's) Pond; thence on the same course to the easterly side, or part, of Lovejoy (Lane's) Pond to the intersection of a straight line drawn from a stone monument on the easterly shore of said pond and marked thus: "TL" and "1901" on north side, "1911" on south side, "R" on east side, and "W" on west side, to a stone monument on the northerly shore of the northeast branch of Lovejov (Lane's) Pond, this stone monument being marked "TL-1901-1911," "R" on east side and "F" on west side. The intersection point thus designated is the southeast corner of the town of Fayette; and from this point, the town line between the town of Fayette and the town of Readfield runs northerly to the last mentioned stone monument; thence to a stone monument standing on the south side of the road leading from Fayette Mills to Kent's Hill and marked "TL-1901-1911," "F" on west side and "R" on east side; thence to a stone monument on the southerly shore of the southeast branch of Crotched Pond and marked "TL-1901-1911," "F" on west side and "R" on east side; thence on the same course to a concrete marker on the easterly shore of the southeast branch of Crotched Pond and marked "TL-1932," "F" on west side and "R" on east side; thence on the same course to the south line of the town of Mt. Vernon, the point of intersection being marked by a concrete marker with the letter "M" on the north side, "F" on the west side, "R" on the east side, and "TL-1932" on the south side; thence westerly in the south line of Mt. Vernon to the southwest corner of Mt. Vernon; thence northerly in the west line of Mt. Vernon to the stream draining Parker's Pond; thence by said stream to Parkers Pond; thence by the southerly and the westerly in the south line of Chesterville as shown by stone monuments marking said line to the first mentioned bound.
