STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Relating to Smelt Fishing in Steuben Bay and Joy's Bay.

Smelt fishing in Steuben Bay and Joy's Bay, so-called, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be and hereby is, directed to repeal all existing rules and regulations pertaining to the netting of smelts in Steuben bay and in Joy's bay, so-called, and to issue rules and regulations (I) prohibiting the use of gill nets, dip nets or any other traps to net smelts in Steuben bay and Joy's bay, so-called; (2) requiring all owners of mud weirs in said bay to place in the back of the pound an opening covered with not less than a 2 inch mesh netting from October 1st to June 1st of each year, providing, however, that bag nets may be used from January 1st to April 1st of each year; and (3) prohibiting the taking of smelts from all streams emptying into said bay.
