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**RESOLVE, Relating to Close Time on Lobsters West of Petit Manan Point.**

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**Lobsters; close time on. Resolved:** That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to repeal the following rule and regulation:

“No person or persons shall set any traps or other device used for catching lobsters between the 1st day of July and 9 o'clock in the forenoon of August 31st of each year, under a penalty of \$5 for each trap or other device set within the following described limits: Beginning at Bear Cove, on the western side of Petit Manan Point, thence in a straight line of Little Black Ledge; thence in a straight line in a southwesterly direction to Schoodic Island whistling buoy.”
