# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

## AN ACT Relative to Regulating the High and Low Water Mark on Lake Moxie.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

High and low water mark on Lake Moxie regulated. No person, firm or corporation shall so operate any dam, water gates or fish screen that the height of water in Lake Moxie or Moxie Pond, so-called, in Somerset county, shall be raised more than 5 feet above, nor be lowered more than 5 feet below the normal water level of said pond.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for each offense.
