STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Recording all Deeds Affecting the Title of Real Estate in the City of Eastport by the City Clerk.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Deeds affecting titles in Eastport to be recorded with city clerk. That the registrar of deeds of Washington county is hereby required to send all deeds affecting the title of property in the city of Eastport subsequent to this act becoming effective after recording such deeds to the city clerk of the city of Eastport and said clerk is hereby required to make full record of such deeds. Said deeds to be recorded in books properly indexed and suitable for such purpose.
