STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Certain Islands in Frenchman's Bay.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain islands made a part of Long Island Plantation. The following islands, located in Frenchman's Bay and contiguous to Long Island Plantation, to wit: Pond Island, Black Island, Calf Island, Eagle Island, Sheep Island, are hereby made a part of said Long Island.
