STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Transferring the Powers and Duties of the Treasurer of State to Other State Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Transfer of powers and duties of treasurer of state. All the powers and duties formerly given to the treasurer of state are hereby transferred to the state controller and such other state officers as under the provisions of law can properly carry out and fulfill such powers and duties.

It is the intent of this act that the powers and duties of the treasurer of state should be given to other existing officers of the state; and the revisor of statutes is hereby directed to prepare and present to the legislature as soon as is practicable a bill achieving this result.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect at the effective date of any constitutional amendment abolishing the office of the treasurer of state.
