STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Trailers used in agricultural purposes. Trailers, without registration or license, may be attached to registered trucks when used for the furtherance of agricultural purposes when owned by farmers owning 2 or more pieces of land.
