STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Qualification of Agents of Insurance Companies
Which Insure Only Members of Non-Political, Secret, Fraternal and
Ritualistic Organizations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 60, § 125, additional. Section 125 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding to said section, after the second paragraph thereof, the following:

'And further providing that no personal examination or examination fee shall be required of a resident of the state when applying for a license to solicit insurance written by any insurance company limiting its risks to members of a non-political, secret, fraternal, ritualistic organization.'
