STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Trapping Season in the Southern Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Trapping season in southern counties, regulated. The trapping season as defined, limited and regulated by the provisions of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, for the counties of Androscoggin, Cumberland, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Sagadahoc, Waldo, York, shall be from November 1 to December 15 of each year, both days inclusive; subject, however, to the present exceptions and special provisions in said section 72 for the counties above enumerated.
