STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Pleasant Pond Tributaries.

Fishing in tributaries of Pleasant Pond regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be and hereby is directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to fishing under the general law, the tributaries, wherever situated, to Pleasant Pond; said pond being in Otisfield and Casco.
